The Understanding Hate Crime training course discusses hate crimes/incidents, while teaching participants to identify them in practice. The course analyses the prevalence of hate crime in Scotland using up to date statistics.

The course focuses on the impact of hate crime on victims, witnesses and communities across Scotland. It examines current hate crime laws and legislation and their efficacy.

The course reviews the five protected characteristics under the Equality Act 2010 and looks at how to respond effectively and sensitively to the needs of victims and witnesses in the aftermath of hate crimes/incidents. It considers the barriers to reporting hate crime and looks at the role of third party reporting centres.
