This course examines the key provisions of the UNCRC and discusses the 42 Articles within. It also covers changes under the Children and Young People (Scotland) Act 2014 such as the role of the Named Person and the Getting It Right For Every Child (GIRFEC) approach.

The course highlights the organisations and initiatives that enable children to exercise their rights such as the Children's Parliament.

Participants will have the opportunity to apply learning to their role and to discuss how they can both uphold children's rights and support children to exercise those rights.
